

"The best-laid plans of mice and men often go awry" is a quote by Robert Burns (Auld Lang Syne). It is also applicable to our life in January. I wrote last time that we were going to Australia and New Zealand in January.

Around Thanksgiving, I started having Flu-like symptoms; I was tested for Covid and Flu (*negative*) but became sicker and sicker. Shortly before our long trip, I went to my doctor, and after many tests, it came out that I had pneumonia. I was strongly advised to postpone the long journey, so we are now going from February 5-28. Unfortunately, I may not be back in time for my next article; *we'll see*.

I am always thankful to my editors for their patience and support. Without them, there is no point in my articles. As some of you know, my articles are written for **The Mariner's Needle** and also published in the **Crews News**.

Unfortunately, the editors of Crews News, **Pat & Paul Gadbois**, have decided to hang up their hats after 25 years. Fortunately, **Tammy & Chris Taunt** have decided to take it over, and Tammy has asked me to continue. I am excited about that! I believe the first issue of Crews News is in March.

At the **January** challenge, we stayed with lights once more, as the days are still short. So, my question was based on USCG Rule 26, which deals exclusively with lights and shapes on board fishing vessels. Rule 3 (d) says that a "vessel engaged in fishing" is defined as fishing with nets, lines, trawls, or other fishing apparatus restricting maneuverability. Rule © (ii) says that an all-round white light is mandated when the gear is more than 150 meters, almost 500 feet from the vessel. This Rule is not for your power boat with a line or two overboard. The color of this light must be white.

For the **February** challenge, I would like us to look at our conduct in restricted visibility. The rules are identical to INLAND and INTERNATIONAL, which is not always the case. So your vessel is underway in restricted visibility.

You hear a fog signal of another vessel, forward of the starboard beam. My question is: which of the following actions should you take?

- A) Alter the course to starboard to pass around the vessel's stern.
- B) Slow your engines and let him pass ahead of you.
- C) Reduce your speed to the minimum, which will keep you on course.
- D) Alter course to port to pass him on his port side.

I have said it before and will say again that the answer can be found in the latest **Navigation Rules & Regulations Handbook** copy. By law, you may not be required to have a copy on board, but I think it is a darn good idea.

I also hope you plan to take a course from our Americas Boating Club Oceanside. America's Boating course started on January 10, and the Engine Maintenance course and Advanced Navigation courses are underway. We are considering teaching a PILOTING course soon. 
