

e have a new, one year lease with OYC and we can now plan our classes again.

Engine Maintenance Class and America's Boating Course will be over on March 30 and March 28.

We will continue on with Marine Electrical System starting on Thursday March 30, 2023 and a Marine Navigation Class (Piloting) class on Tuesday, April 4, 2023.

The Marine Electrical System class is a must for anyone rewiring their boat. There is a reason why you should not use parts from the Home Depot. In class this will be explained. Instructor **Lt. Jorge Alanso, AP** will bring the right tools to use and show you in detail how to do the work. *See picture from last class.*



This Marine Navigation class will teach how to use a chart with confidence and understanding. True North and Mag-



netic North, use magnetic course, plot a DR on the course line, Fixes and Waypoints.

A handheld **Garmin GPSmap76Cx** will be used to make waypoints. A waypoint uses signals from four satellites and how to convert the information to Latitude and Longitude. See picture of Garmin used. Our lead instructor for this course is **Lt/C Darryel Simmons, AP** with other assisting instructors.

We can also use WEDNESDAYS for classes too. **D/Lt Cida Diehl, SN-CN** and I are willing to help other members with JN and N. *Let us know.*

A flyer for the two new classes has been given to the Harbor Master's office and also placed in OYC.
