S.E.O. EDUCATION UPDATE

The life vest give away is over.

Many new faces walked away with a smile on their face, a new life west after being a star a "**1200 Wear it**". At this time of the day, a life vest picture was taken all over the country by the **USPS/ABC Boating Club**.

I knew that many of the participants did not know how the inflatable Class 3 works. At 1200 I set of my inflatable, by pulling the string (*I had notified the people next to me*), but the noise relay surprised many! Now all the people in the picture know. See Cover page.

I walked around in the group and explained to many how my vest would automatically set itself off in water or when I pulled the line with a red plastic marker. Picture of an inflated Type 3 and a regular TYPE 3 are shown by our **EXO Darryel, AP** and **myself**.

To learn more about **Seamanship**, the laws and regulations you should take the **Americas Boating Course**. Passing this course will allow you to apply for the **California Boating Card**. After 2025 all boaters operating a boat, sail and power must have it.

If there is interest in this, we can run an ABC class with the goal for students to pass what they need to understand. You can also go to **The Department for Boating and Water Ways** and take the test there.

We are starting the **Marine Electrical Systems Class** on **Thursday, June 8th at 1900.** (7pm). The Classroom is the OYC room first floor. <u>Please sign in online</u>. Cash or check will be taken at the door too.

The instructor is **Jorge Alonso, AP** and he knows the subject very well. He will bring tools and other teaching materials to class. Some of it will be hands on. See you there.

SAFETY LESSONS LEARNED FROM THE ...



May 20-26 was National Safe Boating Week in preparation for this year's boating season. The US Coast Guard urged us to take a moment to reflect on the boating behaviors that will keep you, your loved ones, and those around you safe while on the water. Their focus was wearing an approved Life Jacket, taking a boating safety course, and filing a float plan with someone you trust. *New in the recommendation to file a float plan is to include a recent photo of your boat.* This seems like a great idea, particularly if the picture is digital.

For three days leading up to your July 4th celebrations, the US Coast Guard is organizing "**Operation Dry Water**," as alcohol use remains the leading contributing factor in fatal boating incidents. The heightened alert for those violating boating under the influence (BUI) laws invites local media, businesses, and recreational boaters to spread the message and raise awareness of the dangers of boating under the influence.

And lastly, I received some questions about the rules regarding fire extinguishers. So rather than writing a whole page about this topic, let me point you to the updated fire extinguisher requirements for recreational boats. <u>https://uscgboating.org/recreational-boaters/fire-extinguisher-faq.php</u> It comes with a series of 16 questions, and if you find that you already know the answer to all questions, you're a better boater than I am!

We stayed with sound signals for power-driven vessels in INLAND waters for the May challenge. So I asked what sound signal is required when your power-driven vessel is leaving a dock or berth. However, in reality, even sailing vessels are power-driven most of the time when leaving the dock, right? The question seems so simple, but there is still some complexity hiding in the choice of my answers. I received one response that it should be one long blast. Look at Rule 32 for the definition of sound signals. I received one reply saying it should be one long and three short blasts. Also not correct because the three short blasts indicate astern propulsion (and the vessel may be leaving the dock going forward). The answer can be found in US Coast Guard Rule 34 (g). Note that there is no section 34 (g) for INTERNATIONAL. The proper response is C, one prolonged blast.

We are looking at anchor lights INLAND and INTERNA-TIONAL waters for next month's challenge. Let me start by saying that four vessels do not (have to) show anchor lights. Extra points for my readers that know all four. However, I'm asking for one: *Which of the following vessels, when anchored at night, would NOT be required to show anchor lights?*

- A) A power-driven vessel.
- B) A vessel engaged in pilotage duty.
- C) A vessel dredging.
- D) A sailing vessel.

Even if you immediately know the answer, I hope you consider taking a course from our **Americas Boating Club Oceanside**. The next class, Marine Electrical Systems, will start on **June 8, 2023 at OYC at 7.00pm** with instructor **Jorge Alonso**. And if we have 5 or more we will start the **Marine Navigation (Piloting)** class. We will teach an **"On the Water Boating Program"** with **Shawn Goit** as the instructor in the classroom and on the water.




