S.E.O. EDUCATION UPDATE



September is here and we can plan our fall classes.

On September 12, 2023 at 700.pm. we will start another <u>Americas Boating Club Class</u>. This class is the basis for all the other classes and is therefore a "must" for us to offer each year. It gives the student a taste of what we can offer for them to understand boats, sail and power, rules of the road and the responsibility for the captain and crew.

The class also gives the students an understanding of charts and how we use the chart to find our direction. *And where we want to go*. Time of arrival is learned by using 60D = S T. Passing this class you can use the Certificate to obtain your Boating Card.

We provided two Seminars in August: GPS and Paddle Smart.

I owned an aluminum canoe once and used it a lot on the **Russian River**, the *slow running* part. I have also tipped over canoes in the **Little Cedar**, **Iowa** several times. It is surprising how strong a river with depth of 2 – 3 feet can suddenly become.

We have scheduled an Engine Maintenance starting October 05. This class is also a "must" for all boaters, both sail and power. The class will run for 10 weeks.

The **Marine Electronic** class exams have been mailed to Headquarters for grading. Thank you to our great instructor **Jorge Alonso**, **AP** for teaching the class.

SAFETY LESSONS LEARNED FROM THE ...






rom the fear that **San Diego**, **Oceanside**, and even **Catalina Island** were squarely in the path of a serious hurricane, to the relief that it changed into a tropical storm veering to the east, away from the coast and our harbors, **Hilary** still became *"a storm to remember"*.

Hilary brought widespread flooding through **Southern California**, washing out roads and bridges in many areas, flooding cars and homes and shutting down businesses.

One warning particularly struck me: *an evacuation order for visitors to Catalina Island.* It would be so hard to decide leaving your boat behind, tied up to a mooring in **Avalon** or **Two Harbors.** But in hindsight we could all agree: it could have been worse!



While we now live in the Midwest, we were glued to the NOAA Weather Channel, talked to our boating friends in California, and even watched Oceanside Harbor on our Club's webcam https://

www.youtube.com/@sanluisreyusps1794/live. Thank you Nancy Kangas, our web master, and her team who drove this project and allows us all to connect.

Last month we looked at overtaking and, although we are not all in the business of racing or competition, we will still have to deal with this issue from the **being overtaken** perspective. I approached the question from the perspective of a powerdriven vessel overtaking another vessel, INLAND and in sight of one another. My question had a lot of internet-searchable clues on where to find the answer in the **USCG Navigation Rules**, pointing to Rule 34 (c). I asked: You are (INLAND) a power-driven vessel overtaking another vessel, in sight of one another, on her starboard side. The answer is that you should sound a whistle signal of one short blast – answer A. Our **District Commander Allan Bombard**, one of my regular respondents, came back quickly with the right Rule and Answer. But before we move on to next month's challenge, let me point out one interesting element of this simple issue. Read the Rule again and you'll see that this is only relevant when the overtaken vessel is also a power-driven vessel. To me that implies that, when your (overtaking) vessel is power-driven and the other vessel (overtaken) is a sailing vessel then Rule 34 (c) does not apply. **Please tell me if you knew this already.**

Now for **September's** challenge. You are (INLAND) operating your vessel through a narrow channel and you must stay within the channel to navigate safely. Another vessel is crossing your course from starboard to port, and you are in doubt of as to her intentions. You _____

- A) may sound the danger signal.
- B) must sound the danger signal.
- *C)* should sound one short blast to indicate that you are holding course and speed.
- D) are required to back down.

So find me the Rule, and the answer, and consider what the response shall be of the overtaken vessel. Also, compare this to the INTERNATIONAL side of the rule and find the one word that would change your answer to this question.

To learn more, I hope you consider taking a course from our <u>Americas Boating Club Oceanside</u>. The next course starts on 12 September. This will feature the use of charts and plotting tools. This was the way to navigate before GPS was invented. You might have to use this method if you lose your connection or just lost your GPS! It happens to the best of us. We can shorten the course if you only want to get "**The Boating Card**". We are preparing to teach the <u>Engine Maintenance</u> <u>Course</u> and will start this class on **October 05, 2023.**

We are also in full swing teaching an "*On the Water Boating Program*" with **Shawn Goit** as the instructor in the classroom and on the water. To see if you can join, don't hesitate to get in touch with **Jan Follestad** at <u>https://americasboatingcluboceanside.org/</u> <u>classroom/</u>




