Now our Class is over and the majority of students have passed, qualifying for the Boater Card.


The two instructors, **Dennis Alba** and **Jan Follestad** are happy with the



SAFETY LESSONS LEARNED FROM THE ...





et's all agree, the weather is drastically different than what we expect. California has been hit with the biggest storms of the season, which were slated to deliver potential damage and lifethreatening rain, wind, and flooding to our region. The 'atmospheric river' is being supercharged by warming ocean waters, causing significant downpours, and offering a preview of the region's future. A saving grace is that we fortunately receive timely warnings from **NOAA.**

In **February** I had the privilege to attend our **Annual Conference** in **Orlando**, where education is one of the major threads of interest. And in **March** I attended the **District 28 Conference** in **Newport Beach**. They did an outstanding job in hosting this event. Not surprisingly, we live in the reality that many of our courses are now offered in some online or electronic format. In both venues, we think that the area of change and growth is our on-the-water training. Our Club in **Oceanside**, together with our friends in the **San Diego Club**, are at the forefront of **OTW Training** in the nation.

I had opportunity to test and qualify five experienced sailors to reach their next "On-The-Water" certificate level, an overnight endeavor. We are lucky to have the USPS National leader, R/C Shawn Goit, to organize this endeavor. We also had the Past Chief Commander Craig Fraser join us and receive his next certification. But at the top of this event was, most certainly, our own P/D/C Richard Cross who reached the pinnacle of training and become an Ocean Navigator. It was said that this was at the top of his bucket list, making him the eleventh 'ON' in the nation. Congratulations to P/D/C Richard Cross, SN-ON! (See photos on Page 7)

For my March challenge I wrote, for INTERNATIONAL waters, that you're entering a crossing situation with another power-driven vessel. Your heading is 315° (North-West) and the other vessel is a 90° (East) course, off your port bow. You are in sight of one another and the vessel off your port bow blows one short blast. What is the proper action for you to take?

I had several readers respond, with different ideas, though all agreed that the correct answer is B, hold course and speed. This is simply based on Rule 34 (a) that the other vessel says: "I am altering my course to starboard" and no answer (blast) is required or even appropriate.

One suggestion was Rule 14, though that only deals with a Head-on situation. *Not applicable*.

Another suggestion was Rule 17 (a) (ii) which deals with your action to avoid collision IF the other vessel is not taking appropriate action. *Also, not applicable.*

I would like to point out that Rule 34 (a) is different for INLAND. In that case, the meaning of one short blast is "I intend to leave you on my port side" and you shall, if in agreement, sound the same signal and take action. Of course, in disagreement you sound the danger signal.

I also asked where you will find the Demarcation Lines for **San Diego, Mission Bay**, and **Oceanside**? In my Rules Handbook it is on page 155, § 80.1104 – San Diego, § 80.1106 – Mission Bay, and § 80.1108 – Oceanside. Basically, the demarcation line is 'in line' with the coast.

For my **April** challenge, let's stay where we were: two power-driven vessels in INTERNATIONAL waters, in sight of one another. Except in this case you are overtaking the other vessel, on her port side, but without changing course. Draw this again if you need. You:

A: should sound two short blasts.

B: should sound the danger signal.


C: should sound one long blast.

D: need not sound any whistle signal.

To be clear, you are not in a narrow channel, or nearing a bend with obstructions. As always, I am asking for your choice, and the applicable Rule in the **USCG Navigation Rules & Regulations**. You may also compare the procedure with the Rules, if you were INLAND.


